

Des Moines violence meets more powerful force

Iowa's capital city is reeling from a wave of violence over the past year, including the killing of police officers and a historic spike in homicides.

"As a community, our conversations have been addressing the wave of violence in our city," said Regenerate7 founder Al Perez. "However, we know that we need to take our conversations to prayer with the Lord as the city Church if we want to see our city transformed. This is the challenge we are facing, like Goliath in the face of David."

another crime scene? Right now city leadership is scrambling for answers. Do you believe we have them? We are meeting for a massive prayer rally. ... Please make it a priority.”
