


Quick response: Trump tweets military transgender ban

On July 26, President Trump [announced](#) via Twitter that “the United States Government will not accept or allow ... Transgender individuals to serve in any capacity in the U.S. Military.”

President Trump states his case in terms of military effectiveness. To that end, we must recognize that redefining gender cannot be our military's top priority. If embracing transgenderism in the ranks compromises the safety of the American people, then, as politically incorrect as it may be,

President Trump made the right call.
